1. Military Educator of the Year (school, military member, or civilian). A recipient could be someone who is not a VA-ACME member but is nominated by a VA-ACME member.

Eligibility: A person directly serving military members in a military educational arena.

Criteria: An individual who made a significant contribution to military education. VA-ACME member must submit the nomination.

Submit package to include the following:

- a. VA-ACME Awards application form.
- b. Prepare 200-300 word double-spaced essay describing the nominee's contributions to military education.

2. VA-ACME President's Award. Service award for lifetime contributions to military education.

Eligibility: An individual or organization making a significant contribution that advances the cause of military education.

Criteria: VA-ACME Executive Board selects recipient of the award. Nominations accepted from VA-ACME members. Individuals may nominate themselves. Nominations should include name of individual making the nomination, contact information (phone #; email address); name of the nominee and their contact information and a short essay on why this individual deserves recognition by the VA-ACME Board.

Submit package to include the following:

- a. VA-ACME Awards application form.
- b. Prepare 200-300 word double-spaced essay describing the nominee's contributions to military education.



3. Sponsorship Award - Corporate/institution sponsor of VA-ACME. Recipient would receive a medallion/plaque and a certificate, to be determined by the award committee.

Eligibility: Award is presented in recognition for outstanding contributions and accomplishments to an organization in recognition of its significant contributions to the cause of military education.

Criteria: VA ACME Executive Board selects recipient of the award. Nominations accepted from VA-ACME members. Organizational representatives may nominate their organization. Nominations should include name of individual making the nomination, contact information (phone #; email address); point of contact information for the nominee and a short essay on why this individual deserves recognition by the VA-ACME Board.

Submit package to include the following:

- a. VA-ACME Awards application form.
- b. Prepare 200-300 word double-spaced essay describing the nominee's contributions to military education.

4. VA-ACME Volunteer of the Year Award – An individual who has contributed to VA-ACME through volunteer efforts.

Eligibility: Award is presented to a VA-ACME member for recognition of outstanding contributions and accomplishments to the cause of military education and the VA-ACME.

Criteria: Each VA-ACME committee chair will submit a name of a deserving member for volunteer of the year award. VA-ACME Executive Board will select recipient of the award. Individuals may not nominate themselves.

Submit package to include the following:

- a. VA-ACME Awards application form.
- b. Prepare 200-300 word double-spaced essay describing the nominee's contributions to military education.
